

June 28-30 at North Central 4-H Camp in Carlisle, KY. This is for youth aged 5-8. Cost is \$165.


Teen Conference:





Servings: 2 Serving Size: 1/2 half of bagel

- 1 whole-grain bagel, halved
- ¼ cup cream cheese or ricotta cheese
- ½ cup sliced strawberries
- Honey or maple syrup
- Cinnamon (optional)

Directions:

- 1. Spread each half of the bagel with 2 tablespoons of cream cheese or ricotta.
- Sprinkle each bagel half with strawberries.
- 3. Drizzle with honey or maple syrup. Sprinkle with cinnamon (optional).
